JOAN E. DUNCAN, BSc, MBE (1916 – 2012)

Joan was a founder member of the Wharfedale Naturalists' Society. This society still flourishes, with a membership of over 500. She was interested in wildlife in general, but botany was her main love and she was an excellent field botanist, with the gift of enthusing others. She became a member of the BSBI in 1953.

Joan was an active member and became President of both the Yorkshire Naturalists' Trust (now the Yorkshire Wildlife Trust) and the Yorkshire Naturalists' Union. She was awarded the MBE in 2001 for services to wildlife conservation in Yorkshire, partly for her work in Grass Wood YWT Reserve, beginning when the Trust managed small areas of the wood, to the acquisition of the whole wood in 1983. Joan chaired the Grass Wood Committee until 1993.
